



Key Stage 4 Core Curriculum and Option Subjects

Media

Students will follow OCR Cambridge Nationals Certificate Level 2 in Creative iMedia

Students will begin the course in Year 9 and will complete it over a three year period, including mandatory examination and coursework units along with 2 additional coursework units.

The course allows students to develop transferable skills which will be of great benefit to their future.

The Cambridge Nationals in Creative iMedia will equip learners with a range of creative media skills and provide opportunities to develop, in context, desirable, transferable skills such as research, planning, and review, working with others and communicating creative concepts effectively.

These qualifications provide opportunities for the development of the Functional Skills of:

- *English: Speaking and Listening, Reading and Writing*
- *Mathematics: Representing, Analysing and Interpreting*
- *ICT: Use ICT systems, Find and select information and Develop, present and communicate information*

Progression

The course offers direct progression to the Level 3 OCR Cambridge Technical qualification which is respected by universities and employers, therefore providing students successful progression.

Course Content

Unit R081 – Pre-production Skills

Unit R082 – Creating Digital Graphics

The further 2 units will be chosen based upon students' interests and skills in the subject, including: Websites, digital animation, photography, sound, and Gaming.



Assessment

The course is comprised of 1 examination unit which is externally assessed and 3 coursework units. The coursework units will be completed and assessed throughout the 3 year study period.
