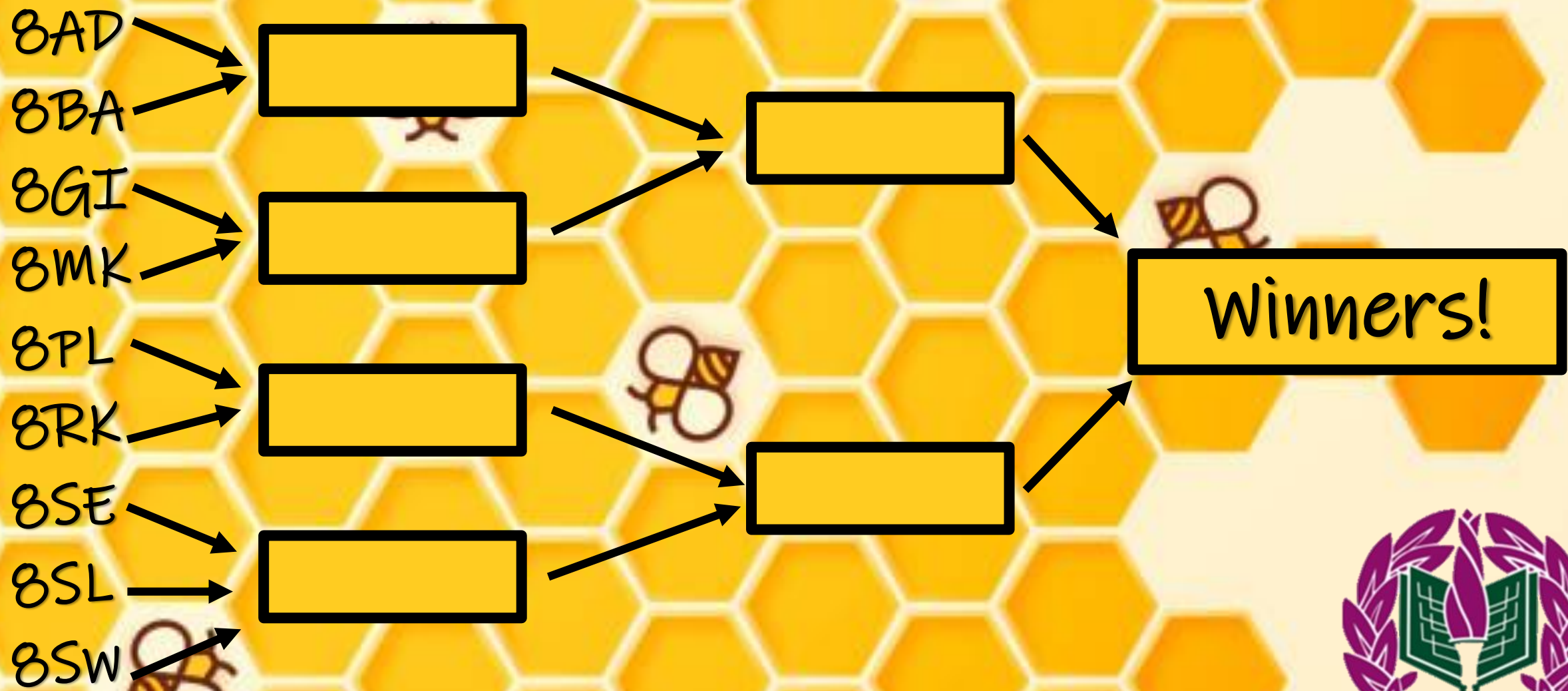
Welcome to the Year 8 Spelling Bee!

Historically, women have been denied the right to vote, to work, and lots of other things, too. Because of brilliant women who fought against these things, women have a lot more say in the world around us now. But there are still many issues that women continue to face and fight for today.



As well as celebrating brilliant women, it's also used as a day to highlight and raise awareness about issues that women still face.

How did International Women’s Day begin?
Over 100 years ago in 1910, International Women’s Day was first celebrated, with the aim to have equality for men and women across the world, which we are still fighting for today.
The group of women who led the fight were called the Women’s Social and Political Union, otherwise known as the Suffragettes. They were a strong and active group of women who wore the colours purple, green and white, which are now associated with International Women’s Day. The Suffragettes campaigned for a woman's right to vote, believing that women should have a say in the decision-making process of important issues.

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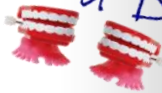
