## BTEC Subsidiary Diploma Performing Arts Acting

### Entry Requirements

Minimum of 5 grade 4 (new grading structure) at GCSE or equivalent. Grade 5 or equivalent in your chosen study subject is preferred.

### Course Description

The course in performing arts is equivalent to one A level allowing students to study a range of subjects alongside it. Students will have the opportunity to explore the performing arts industry and the range of careers available. There is also the opportunity to explore a variety of performance styles in a practical learning environment and then put them into practice in performances.

### Assessment

There are three assessments where students will be assessed on their practical skills as well as written portfolios in response to their practical work:

- Planning a career in the industry
- Exploring performance styles
- Performing for an audience
