Dear Families of New Year 7 students,

I hope you have had an enjoyable and relaxing summer break. As new members of the Academy family, we are really looking forward to meeting you on Tuesday 3rd September. In this letter, I have included some key information to ensure the term starts with a smooth transition.

Start of the day:

For all Year 7 students, the new term will start at 8.20am on Tuesday 3rd September. Students will need to enter through the **Lord Street Entrance** (the gates will be open from 8.15am), where they will be greeted by the Senior Leadership Team, Head of Year (Mr Taylor), Assistant Head of Year (Mr Anderson) and Year 7 Form Tutors. They will then line up with their Form Tutor and spend some time settling in and refreshing their memories about key routines and procedures. Please can you ensure your child brings the letter with them, which tells them which Form Group they are in so that they can go straight to the right place when they come into school.

Uniform and ties:

All students will need to be dressed in the correct Academy uniform. If you have not been able to purchase a tie, please do not worry, students can purchase these during Form Time. Please can you ensure students bring £5 with them on the first day, to make the purchase.

Data Collection Forms:

If you have not yet done so, please can you complete the Data Collection Forms to ensure that we have the most up to date information about your child, in case of an emergency. This can be done on the paper copy posted out.

Free School Meals:

Class Charts:

Class Charts is an online platform through which important information such as homework, behaviour, detention (date and time) and general announcements are shared with Parents/Carers. It is vital that we have accurate email addresses for all Parents/Carers as login details and instructions to access accounts will be emailed out next week.
